**Comments:** Normal growth observed

During the January Account Inspection, Cattails were observed within the littoral area of the site, along with debris which had likely flown into the waterway with the storm water from the rain that was received on the previous evening.

**Management Summary**

While performing the January Account Inspection for Thurston Groves, it was observed that the water levels had risen due to a precipitation event that occurred the evening before this inspection. Debris was also observed within the littoral area, and was likely carried into the waterway with the wind and storm water from the experienced storm.

Cattails were observed growing within the littoral area of the site, along with some regrowth of Primrose.

The planted beneficial vegetation had continued to mature and expand along the perimeter of the site, and few Plecostomus were observed around the homeowner's side of the lake.

**Recommendations/Action Items**

During our February treatment, Aquatic Systems will focus on the following treatments:

- Our technician and Service Manager will wade the littoral shelf, targeting all growth of Cattails and Primrose.
- The debris observed within the site will be removed.
- Continue to spot-spray undesired vegetation amongst the littoral area, as well as along the perimeter of the site.
- Monitor the health of the Florida Native aquatic vegetation that was planted.
- Continue to monitor the burrowing behavior of present wildlife.
- Follow up with all previous treatments to ensure desired results are achieved.

Aquatic Systems, Inc. will continue to care for the waterway within the Thurston Groves community.
